35 Thens and One Now: A Brief History of Desna

The Desna Ukrainian Dance Company of Toronto has a 35-year history that is as diverse and colourful as the dances it performs. As with every long-standing organization, the group has a factual history – and then there are the stories, often spread by proud family members of the performers and usually told in the latter part of a celebratory gathering. These accounts, like many tales of old, contain slivers of truth, but are transformed into pieces of the unofficial epic of Desna's history as they are told and retold with embellishments to yet another generation of dancers being welcomed into the Desna fold.

One of those tales takes place more than 35 year ago, Desna was no more than just an idea that was developed by two spirited Ukrainian fellows, who began contemplating some of the implications of Canada's recently established multicultural policy while watching TV. A great adventure – or misadventure according to some – followed and Desna was left in its wake. These two honourable gentlemen, Bill Balan and George Strohyj, will always be known as the founding members of what is now the Desna Ukrainian Dance Company of Toronto. All members of Desna, past and present, the Ukrainian-Canadian community and many enthralled audiences owe these men a debt of gratitude.

The 'Desna' name was selected by conductor Alexander Chmil (1972-76) from a choral piece performed by the original Desna Choir: a song about the enchanting Desna River in central Ukraine. The group's initial tour across Canada, sponsored by the federal government, took place in the summer of 1972. Upon its conclusion, the members decided that they wanted to continue as the Desna Choir. Two years later, the choir voted to create the Desna Ukrainian Dance Group, under the artistic direction of Andy Malette (1974-79).

The dance group debuted in 1976 to a standing-room-only audience at West Park Collegiate in Toronto. At that moment, those first Desna dancers sowed the seeds of a performing ensemble that would thrill audiences in several nations in the Western world. Desna toured France on two occasions in the mid-1980s under the artistic direction of Mark Olynyk (1979-87) and was invited to return there one more time under the artistic direction of Andrej Baczynskyj (1988-89).

New members kept joining the Desna ranks. Inspired by the feats of their predecessors, they showed they also had that same love for Ukrainian dance and ceaselessly aspired to contribute to the Desna Legacy. In the years that followed, Desna focussed its attention on broadening its fame in the Toronto community, performing in the hit Ukrainian-Canadian comedy Ukrainians on Broadway written by Ihor Baczynskyj, Ron Cahute, and Desna members. The group continued to expand its popularity in the Metro region through numerous television appearances, community shows, and cultural events. Under the artistic direction of Taras Pawluk (1992-95), Desna was requested to perform for Canada's 125th birthday celebration on national television before a live audience that included then Governor General Ray Hnatyshyn.

Desna continued to have an influx of new young talent, determined to show, through sweat, discipline and toil, that they too could and would add a chapter to the Legacy. Since 1999, Desna has had the good fortune of working with two experienced artistic directors and choreographers, Luba and Yuri Grekov. Their energy, passion, and dedication were contagious, and in the years that followed Desna members found themselves enjoying the same level of enthusiasm and drive that they had only heard of in tales about their predecessors in the ensemble. Yuri and Luba brought with them to Desna many years of professional knowledge, both acquired first hand and learned from the disciples of Pavlo Virsky, the "grandfather" of contemporary Ukrainian folk dance.

With the Grekovs' guidance, Desna has gained a noteworthy reputation across North America, resulting in a busy schedule of performances across the continent. In 2002, through an invitation from the Government of Canada, Desna had the great honour of representing the Ukrainian-Canadian Diaspora in a performance for Queen Elizabeth II during her 50th Jubilee celebrations in Toronto. In 2005, in conjunction with Yuri and Luba Grekov and former members of the Virsky Ukrainian National Dance Ensemble, Desna hosted a performance of a broad range of Ukrainian dance talent from Toronto to commemorate the 100th anniversary of Virsky's birth.

This is but a very brief history of Desna, and without a doubt is just the beginning.

An alumnus of The DESNA Ukrainian Dance Company of Toronto, Ukrainian-born soprano Antonina Ermolenko received her B.A. in Vocal Performance from the prestigious *Glenn Gould School of the Royal Conservatory of Music* in Toronto, and her M.A. Degree in the same from *Hunter College, CUNY*, New York.

Ms. Ermolenko's recent performances have included the role of Beatrice in the world premier of Anthony Sbordoni's *The Cenci* with the *Hunter Opera Theater*, NY; Mimi in Puccini's *La Bohème*, as well as the title role in Bizet's *Carmen* for the *New York Lyric Opera*; and another Mimi with the *Martha Cardona Theater*, NY. Last summer, Antonina made her first

acquaintance with La Bohème by portraying Musetta as a participant of the Dell'arte Opera's Standard Repertoire Project.

For the past season, Ms. Ermolenko has been a Resident Artist with the Dicapo Opera Theatre, where she appeared as La Cugina in Puccini's Madama Butterfly, the Contessa Ceprano in Verdi's Rigoletto, and Mavis the Tractor in Picker's Fantastic Mr. Fox.

Antonina's upcoming performances include another run as Mimi with the Martha Cardona Theater; the Montserrat Caballe International Singing Contest and master-class in Zaragoza, Spain, and a debut recital at the Glenn Gould Studio in Toronto.



DESNA Current Artistic Directors



Luba & Yuri Grekov

DESNA is currently honoured to be working under the artistic direction of Luba and Yuri Grekov, graduates of the Virsky National Academy of Dance in Kyiv, Ukraine. In addition to having a comprehensive knowledge of Ukrainian dance, they are also professionally trained in many styles of international dance, including Spanish, Gypsy, Greek, Moldovan, Georgian and Mexican. Having toured throughout Europe and North America, Luba and Yuri performed with Moscow's *GODENKO* dance troupe, Kyiv's *VIRSKY National Dance Company*, and Ukraine's *HOPAK* ensemble.

Upon first arriving in Canada, Luba and Yuri became artistic directors of the *RUSALKA* Ukrainian Dance Ensemble in Winnipeg, Manitoba. They also simultaneously directed the *VESNIANKA* Dance Ensemble at Thunder Bay's Ukrainian Institute "Prosvita" from 1994 to 2007. In 2003 their mutual desire to unite Ukrainian dance communities throughout the world led to the creation of the "International Summer School of Ukrainian Dance" in Kyiv, Ukraine.

Luba and Yuri teach the original and most authentic style of Ukrainian dance - *Virsky* style, which encompasses an in-depth ethnological knowledge and conveys the spirit and richness of Ukrainian dance. For ten years and counting, they have been essential sources of artistic and creative vision for the DESNA Ukrainian Dance Company of Toronto.
