

About Desna

Over the past 45 Years, Desna has been dazzling audiences throughout Canada, the US and the rest of the world with a wide range of Ukrainian dance. Under the direction of Virskytrained Yuri & Luba Grekov, Desna presents technically demanding and exhilarating dances accented by exquisite costumes and diverse music.

Various traditional Ukrainian dances make up Desna's repertoire including Hutsul, Bukovynian, Volyn, Kozachok and Hopak, but it's the group's belief that the key to celebrating and broadening tradition lies with new and different styles of dance.

DESNA School of Ukrainian dance is a place where children not only experience Ukrainian culture and tradition, but also create lasting friendships and attain unforgettable memories. The school consists of children aged 2 to 15, who practice up to twice a week at the Plast Huculak Centre.

The dancers have performed on many stages including Nathan Phillips Square, The Living Arts Centre, and competed at the National Ukrainian Festival in Dauphin, Manitoba. Over the last 3 years, the school has shown tremendous growth and rejuvenation. Summer 2017, they traveled to Ukraine where they danced their way through many regions learning more about the Ukrainian dance and culture. This past summer they traveled with the company to Yonkers, New York, where they participated in their first full length show. We continue to look for performing opportunities for the students throughout the year and into the summer months.
